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## 1. Written statement of behaviour principles

- Every learner has the right to feel safe, valued and respected, and to be able to learn free from the disruption of others
- All learners, staff and visitors are free from any form of discrimination
- Staff and volunteers model exemplary behaviour at all times
- Rewards, consequences and reasonable force are used consistently by staff, in line with the Relationships and Positive Behaviour policy
- The Relationships and Positive Behaviour policy is understood by learners, staff and parents/carers
- The Suspension and Permanent Exclusion policy explains that exclusions will only be used as a last resort, and outlines the processes involved in suspensions and exclusions
- Learners are helped to take responsibility for their actions where appropriate
- Families are informed of behaviour incidents to foster good relationships between the school and learners' home life

The governing board also emphasises that violence or threatening behaviour will not be tolerated in any circumstances.

This written statement of behaviour principles is reviewed and approved by the full governing board annually.
